

NUA Tuition Fee Status Assessment Process

Your tuition fee status will be officially assessed through the NUA Admissions Portal from April 2023 if you have firmly accepted a conditional or unconditional offer from NUA. Through the Portal you will be asked a number of questions about your nationality and residence which will enable us to assess your fee status.

There are two fee statuses - Home and Overseas. The 2023/24 fee rates are as follows:

| Overseas | Undergraduate degree (full-time) | £18,000 |
| Overseas | Postgraduate fee (full-time) | £18,000 |
| Overseas | MArch Architecture (full-time) | £18,000 |

Your fee status depends on whether you meet certain criteria, provided in regulations and guidance published by the English government. If you are a British citizen who will be living in the UK on the 1st September 2023, and you have lived in the UK for 3 years before the 1st September 2023, it is likely you will be assessed as Home fee status.

As the UK has now formally left the EU, new entrants from the EU, EEA and Switzerland without settled status will likely be assessed as Overseas fee status.

There are additional Home categories in the UKCISA guidance referenced above but if you don't fit into any of these categories you will be assessed as Overseas fee status.
